DOMENICO WINES WINS THREE MEDALS IN LONG BEACH GRAND CRU WINE COMPETITION

San Carlos, Calif.—August 18, 2006—Domenico Wines, one of the fastest growing, family-owned artisan wineries in the U.S., was awarded three medals in the 2006 Long Beach Grand Cru Wine Competition this month. The Long Beach Grand Cru has received accolades as the “up-and-coming” competition of the millennium. Since its inception in 1995, the Grand Cru has grown in size and prestige, attracting wineries from across the U.S. and from around the world. In 2006, there were 455 wineries from 23 states and 10 countries submitting 1,901 entries. Domenico Wines that were awarded medals are:

The Long Beach Grand Cru is unique in that it provides support to a charity. It is the primary fundraising vehicle for the Long Beach office of the Legal Aid Foundation of Los Angeles. The major public tasting event attracts more than 1,200 wine and food aficionados every August.
