## **DOMENICO WINES GIVEN THREE MEDALS IN THE NEW WORLD INTERNATIONAL WINE COMPETITION**

*Number Of Domenico Awards Now  
84 In Less Than 22 Months*

**San Carlos, Calif.—April 10, 2007**—Domenico Wines, one of the fastest growing, family-owned artisan wineries in the U.S., won three new medals in the 2007 New World International Wine Competition last month. Founded in 1990, the New World Wine Competition is one of the top ten wine competitions in the United States. The competition is limited to wines produced anywhere in the “New World”, which includes North America, Central America, South America, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa. More than 2,000 wines were judged in the 2007 competition. The three new Domenico medals bring the total number of awards to 84 since Domenico was founded less than 22 months ago.

Domenico Wines that were awarded medals are:

2004 Sangiovese – Silver  
2004 Pinotage - Silver  
2004 Nebbiolo - Bronze

The New World International Wine Competition is the only competition in America, and perhaps the world, to pit the best wines from each price class against each other to determine an overall best of variety or type. All wines are judged by price category, ranging from inexpensive through moderate to premium or super-premium prices. Each wine is judged against others of its type and also against its price peers.
