DOMENICO WINES WINS FOUR MEDALS IN FINGER LAKES INTERNATIONAL WINE COMPETITION

*New Awards Bring Total Number Of Domenico Medals
To 93 In Less Than 23 Months*

The competition is open to all wine-producing countries. Last year, the event attracted more than 1,700 wines from across the U.S. and around the globe.

Orange Muscat – Gold
2004 Amador Sangiovese - Silver
2005 Amador Barrel-Aged Chardonnay – Bronze
2004 Amador Nebbiolo – Bronze
