DOMENICO WINES WINS SEVEN MEDALS IN MONTEREY WINE COMPETITION

*Number Of Domenico Awards Now
81 In Less Than 22 Months*

San Carlos, Calif.—April 2, 2007—Domenico Wines, one of the fastest growing, family-owned artisan wineries in the U.S., won seven new medals in the 2007 Monterey International Wine Competition last month. With entries from as far away as New Zealand and South Africa, the Monterey Wine Competition has become a global event. Now in its fourteenth year, the competition focuses on the origin of each wine, realizing that terroir and local custom often determine how a wine is made and ultimately how it tastes. The seven new Domenico medals bring the total number of awards to 81 since Domenico was founded less than 22 months ago. Domenico Wines that were awarded medals are:

- 2004 Aglianico – Gold
- 2004 Sangiovese – Gold
- 2004 Miscela - Silver
- 2005 Malvasia Bianca - Bronze
- 2004 Cabernet Franc – Bronze
- 2004 Merlot - Bronze
- 2004 Port - Bronze

“The Monterey Wine Competition is a blind tasting and wines are judged purely on the merits of taste, not on a particular label or retail price,” said Domenico master winemaker, Dominick Chirichillo. “Domenico has continued to perform extremely well in these fierce competitions and we’re honored to be recognized for our professional accomplishments,” Chirichillo said.

The Monterey Wine Competition is held annually in conjunction with the Salinas Valley Fair in King City, Calif. Award-winning wines will be featured during the fair at the Grand Wine Tasting on May 18, 2007.
