DOMENICO EARNS EIGHT NEW MEDALS

All Eight Domenico Wine Entries Awarded Medals In Santa Cruz Mountains Wine Competition

San Carlos, Calif.—August 10, 2006—Domenico Wines, San Francisco Peninsula’s newest and fastest growing winery, was awarded eight new medals for its eight wine entries last month in the 2006 Santa Cruz Mountains Commercial Wine Competition. Domenico, one of the newest members of the Santa Cruz Mountains Winegrowers Association, entered eight of its 20 newly released wines. The eight Domenico wine entries earned one gold, five silver, and two bronze medals.

The award winning wines are 2004 Amador Barbera (Gold), 2004 Napa Valley Merlot (Silver), 2005 Santa Cruz Mountains Pinot Noir (Silver), 2004 Amador Syrah (Silver), 2004 Napa Valley Miscela (Meritage) (Silver), 2005 Barrel Fermented Chardonnay (Silver), 2004 Amador Zinfandel (Bronze), and the 2004 Amador Aglianico (Bronze).

“Domenico is excited with the debut of its second releases,” said Dominick Chirichillo, Domenico’s master winemaker. “This continued recognition is evidence of our commitment to create outstanding wines,” said Chirichillo. Six of Domenico’s first wine releases won 29 medals in 14 contests in which they were entered.

The Santa Cruz Mountains has been recognized as a premium wine producing region since the late 1800s when local winegrowers first began to win acclaim for their wines in national and international competition.

The public is invited to taste these award-winning wines, along with all the new Domenico 2006 wine releases, at a Wine Release Party on Sunday, September 10, 2006 from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. A private tasting will be held for Trade only on September 12, 2006 from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The Wine Release Party will be held at the Domenico Winery tasting room, which is located at 1697 Industrial Road, San Carlos, Calif.
