Governor Schwarzenegger Declares September California Wine Month; Domenico Hosts Month Long Calendar of Special Events

On September 14, Domenico will be one of the five featured wines at an event hosted by Atherton Appliance & Kitchens, of Redwood City, Calif. On September 22 and 29, Domenico will host “Jazz Uncorked”, a new Friday night concert series that features the Bay Area’s greatest jazz musicians, such as Margie Baker and Nat Pruett.
